

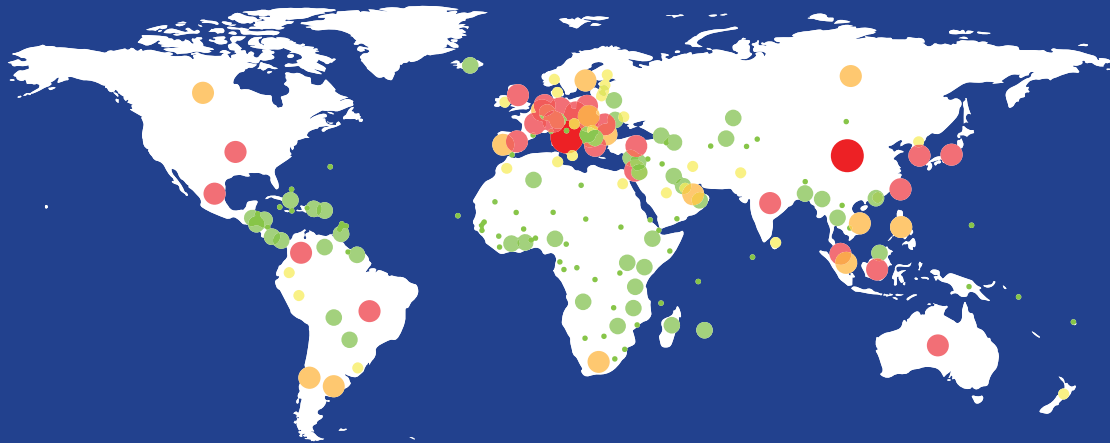

How to Participate

-  Once certifications are searchable, Certification Bodies to send activation invitations to Certified Entities to activate their accounts. Invitations will be sent to the Certified Entities by Certification Bodies or IAF CertSearch.
-  Certified Entities are required to activate their account in IAF CertSearch to appear in the database.



Validation - businesses, governments, regulators from around the world can validate your organizations certifications



Profiles - Certified organizations will receive a company and certification profiles which can be personalised, i.e. uploading a company logo.



Enquiries - Receive enquiries via IAF CertSearch.



IAF CertSearch digital Mark - This mark/digital badge can be placed on your website and will link to your certifications in IAF CertSearch in real time demonstrating your organization holds a valid certification and is part of the global accredited network.



Trade access - Certified organizations will have the ability to activate their profile on the exclusive trade marketplace for accredited certified organization (QualityTrade.com) from within the IAF CertSearch account. Certified organizations who participate in the trade marketplace can receive trade enquiries from businesses and governments.
